AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend printed House Bill No. 836 in Senate, on page 2, Section 2, by striking lines 1 and 2, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“Section 2. The Commission may make arrangements for active participation by Illinois in the 1964-1965”; and

on page 2, Section 2, line 7, by striking the word “insuring” and inserting in lieu thereof the word “arranging”; and

on page 2, Section 3, by inserting after line 4 the following:

“In accordance with the rules of the World’s Fair governing body, the Commission may charge reasonable fees for admission to the Illinois exhibit, or any part thereof, and for the use of its site by Illinois industry, business, chambers of commerce, and other Illinois companies and groups; provided, the Commission shall not charge any fee to the State of Illinois or any of its agencies.”; and

on page 3, Section 6, by inserting after line 4 the following:

“The Commission shall make an accounting to the General Assembly of its receipts from all sources and expenditures for all purposes within three months after the closing date of the New York World’s Fair. As soon as possible after the closing of the World’s Fair in 1965, but not later than June 30, 1966, the Commission shall close its books. Any funds remaining in its account at that time shall be placed in the General Revenue Fund.”; and

21 on page 3, by striking all of Section 7.
