INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

Senators Drach, Dixon, McGlooin and Bidwill introduced Senate Bill No. 57, a bill for "An Act to amend Section 1 of 'An Act creating a commission to enable the State to participate in the New York World's Fair, and making an appropriation therefor', approved July 10, 1963, and making an appropriation in connection therewith."

The bill was read by title, ordered printed and by unanimous consent, on motion of Senator Drach was referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

Senator Rosander introduced Senate Bill No. 58, a bill for "An Act to amend Sections 11-29-3 and 11-29-4 of the 'Illinois Municipal Code', approved May 29, 1961, as amended."

The bill was read by title, ordered printed and, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Assignment of Bills.

Senators Smith and DeTolve introduced Senate Bill No. 59, a bill for "An Act making an appropriation to the Department of Children and Family Services for the demolition, razing and disposal of certain of its facilities."

The bill was taken up, read by title, ordered printed and, by unanimous consent, on motion of Senator Smith, the rules were suspended and the bill read at large the first time and ordered to a second reading, without reference.

Senator Cherry introduced Senate Bill No. 60, a bill for "An Act making an appropriation to the Teachers College Board."

The bill was read by title, ordered printed and, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Assignment of Bills.

Senator Cherry introduced Senate Bill No. 61, a bill for "An Act making an appropriation to the Teachers College Board."

The bill was read by title, ordered printed and, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Assignment of Bills.

Senator Cherry introduced Senate Bill No. 62, a bill for "An Act making a supplemental appropriation for the ordinary and contingent expenses of Northern Illinois University."
