the one from Robert Moses.

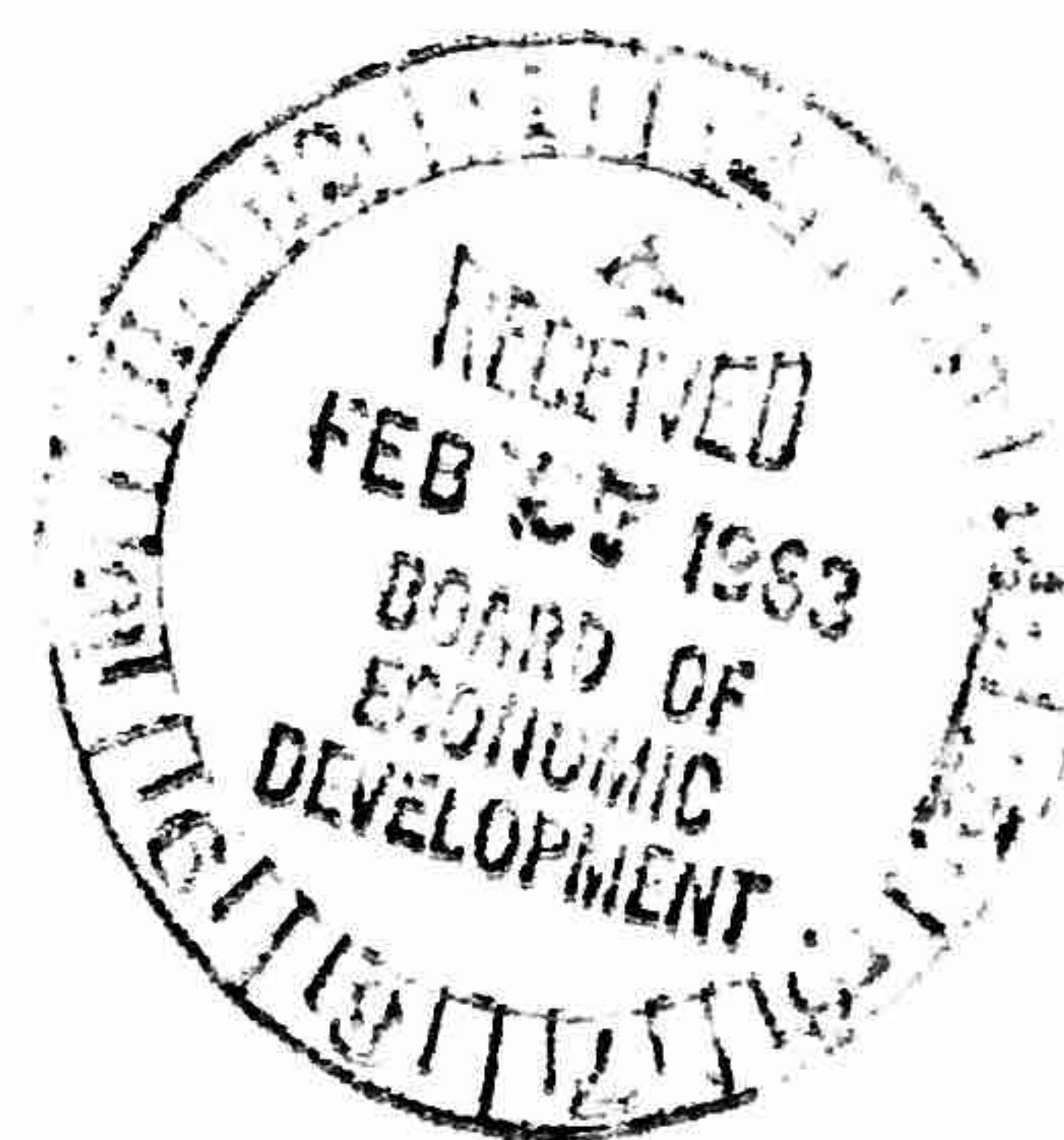
Our committee is being organized for the New York
