Dear Virginia:

This letter will serve as an agreement between you and the Illinois Commission - New York World's Fair.

It is understood that you accept the position of Special Events Director of the Illinois Pavilion. In addition to supervising Special Events activities, you will be responsible for the Pavilion's public relations program, and will administer those in the Pavilion staff who are responsible for VIP reception. Your travel and out-of-pocket expenses in the performance of the duties stated above will be reimbursed by the state voucher system. In compensation for your contractual services, the Commission agrees to pay you a monthly fee of \$333. The period covered by this contract is April 15 and extends through December 31, 1965.

Authorization of this contract is the minutes of the Commission meeting of March 9, 1965.
