I am happy to conclude our negotiations regarding the responsibility for construction costs at the Illinois Pavilion. As agreed in your office on Monday, the Illinois Commission assumes responsibility for the original contract price of the aluminum railings in the gathering area--\$8,000. The Illinois Commission also agrees to make an approximate 50-50 split with WED on the balance of the costs covering scaffold, acoustical spray, painting, duct work, and electrical work. We are happy to accept your suggestion of a \$12,000 responsibility on our part for that balance. Would you please bill the Illinois Commission on the New York World's Fair at our Chicago office address for the \$20,000 total due to WED? According to our present time table, we will be able to pay you from our new appropriation sometime in January, 1965. Ralph and I enjoyed your hospitality in Glendale and hope that you will not come to Chicago without giving us a call so that we can reciprocate.
